ANNUAL AWARD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD GUIDELINES

Purpose in accordance with the MBCIA By-Laws Article 10.1, the MBCIA has established the MBCIA Scholarship Awards. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide tuition assistance to a child or grandchild of an MBCIA member and vocational students for 2022.

AWARD BENEFITS

The MBCIA Scholarship Committee, the MBCIA Budget Committee, and the MBCIA Board of Directors will determine the number and amounts of the scholarship awards to be granted. Recipient(s) will be presented the Scholarship Award(s) at the Annual MBCIA Awards Day Event held in June, 2022, to be announced.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. The **Sponsor** of the applicant must be a member in good standing (all dues paid in full) and in the MBCIA for a minimum of three (3) years.
- B. Applicant must be pursuing a degree on a full-time basis at an accredited college or university. Award is not based on the applicant's particular field of study.
- C. The completed pages 2-3 of the application must be received by June 1, 2022 to the attention of the MBCIA Scholarship Committee Chair and accepted via email only to scholarships@mbcia.org

GUIDELINES

- Application (see page 2-3) is available from the MBCIA web site at <https://www.mbcia.org/scholarships> Completed applications should be addressed to the MBCIA Scholarship Committee and be sent via *email only* to scholarships@mbcia.org and must be received by June 1, 2022. Scholarship applications received may be provided to each MBCIA member on file.
- Selection(s) will be made by the MBCIA Scholarship Committee.
- Awards are presented at the Annual Awards Day Event/Luncheon. If the recipients are unable to attend, the scholarship award will be given to their sponsor (if applicable).
- Recipients must enroll in their Institute within six (6) months of being awarded the MBCIA Scholarship and provide evidence of attendance at said Institute to MBCIA.
